1. *Family income:* Our commitment is to work with families with limited incomes to make access to Crow's Path programming possible. In addition to financial aid, we may also work with families to structure long-term payment plans and/or consider other financing options that support access and affordability.
2. *'Underserved' families:* We understand 'underserved' to reflect one or more of the following factors: limited opportunities for substantial and meaningful connections with nature, limited opportunities for affirming and supportive mentoring relationships, limited opportunities to engage in diverse, multi-aged, educational or social experiences.
3. *Contributions and service:* As an education organization which also supports healthy communities, special consideration is also given to those families whose financial circumstances are limited by the contributions and service which they offer to their own communities to create social health and/or positive environmental change.
