Thank you for your interest in a Crow's Path internship. We're looking for interns that are curious, playful, have a deep connection to the earth, and are passionate about helping others grow and connect to the natural world. As an intern, we ask three main tasks:

1. that each of our interns work with one of our lead mentors, the Flying Squirrels, in the beginning of the session to identify an "expertise" that they want to develop. Previous examples include fire-by-friction, shelter building, candle making, etc.
2. that you work collaboratively with the Crow's Path community on a service project (e.g. bridge building, longhouse construction, working on a dugout canoe).
3. that you share a skill/talent with the group, such as stories, games, songs, food, etc; the ideas are limited only by your creativity and willingness to experiment.
